## Registration

- Registrations are accepted only after full payment is received.
- Payments can be made by e-transfer to [tournament@crysa.bc.ca](mailto:tournament@crysa.bc.ca).

## Eligibility

- All teams and players must be registered with their provincial association and have club permission to participate.
- Short Term Player Permits are available for non-registered players. Contact your club or BC Soccer for more information.

---

## Rosters

- Rosters are required for all teams by Wednesday, April 29th.
- Rosters must include:
  - Player's full name
  - Date of birth

---

## Team Check-In

- A team representative must check in 60 minutes before the first game at the Field Marshal Tent where your team plays to collect the tournament package.

## Tournament Headquarters

- Located at the CRYSA Fieldhouse at Robron Athletic Park
- Staff available throughout the weekend for assistance

---

## Field Locations

- Tournament HQ: Robron Athletic Park
- U10 & U11: Pinecrest School
- U12 & U13: Robron Athletic Park, Pinecrest Park, Pinecrest School
- All U12/U13 fields are within walking distance of one another.

## Field Marshals

- A clearly identified Field Marshal is located at each complex.
- They are the primary contact for teams and officials and are responsible for:
  - Reporting scores
  - Assisting with concerns

---

## Referees

- Referees are supplied for all games.

---

## Ball Requirements

- Game balls provided by CRYSA.
- All games will use a size 4 ball
- Teams must bring their own warm-up balls.

## Levels of Play

### U10 & U11

- Advanced - Competitive
- Community - Recreational

### U12 & U13

- Div 1 – Most competitive
- Div 2 – Mid-range competitive
- Div 3 – Recreational

CRYSA reserves the right to modify or combine divisions depending on registration.

## Group Formats

### U10 & U11 → Festival-Style

- Random draw: each team plays four opponents
- No Standings or scores are kept

### U12 & U13 → Championship-Style

#### Groups of 4 Teams

- Round-robin (each team plays all others once)
- 1st vs 3rd → Semi Final
- 2nd vs 4th → Semi Final
- Winners → Championship Game

#### Groups of 5 Teams

- Full round-robin (each team plays all others once)
- 1st vs 2nd → Championship Game

Groups of 6/7/9/10 Teams

- Random draw: each team plays 4 opponents
- Standings determine matchups:
  - 1st vs 2nd → Championship Game

---

## Point System (U12 & U13)

- Win: 5 points
- Tie: 2 points
- Loss: 0 points
- Goals For: +1 each (max 3)
- Shutout: +1

Tie-Breaker Order in group play

1. Head-to-Head
2. Goal Difference
3. Most Shutouts
4. Most Wins
5. Goals Against

Tie-Breaker in Cup Final

1. Straight to PKs

## Awards

- MVP Pins:
  - Each team receives 4 pins
  - Award one MVP pin per game to a player on the *opposing* team
- Championship Medals:
  - Awarded to 1st and 2nd place teams in U12 & U13 divisions

---

## Championship Medal Ceremonies

Medals are presented in front of the CRYSA Office next to the turf field at Robron Athletic Park.

## Parking

Parking is limited due to the number of games.  
Plan to arrive early and be courteous to local residents.

## Garbage

Teams must clean their bench area after every game.

---

## First Aid

- Certified First Aid volunteers stationed at Robron Athletic Park and Carihi
- Not available at Pinecrest School or Pinecrest Park.
- Work with team staff and Field Marshal for emergencies and call emergency services as needed.
