POLICY FOR TRAVEL AND TOURNAMENT ASSISTANCE

Travel Policy

CRYSA recognizes that participation in league play, tournaments, friendlies or jamborees are a valued component of player development. Teams traveling to participate in such events during, or outside of, the regular schedules (Spring and Fall, Tier 3, UISA) must comply with the following:

Coaches, parents, and participants are reminded that they are ambassadors to our community and should act accordingly.

If coaches are of the opposite gender to players on the team they are coaching, a chaperone of the same gender as the players must be on the bench and travel with the team out of town as well as overnight trips.

If coaches/managers are arranging player rides, all drivers must complete our risk management documents and have a criminal record check and a drivers abstract on file. Each parent is solely responsible to ensure their child has safe transportation to/from games.

All chaperones must have an up-to-date CRC on file with CRYSA.

Any team wishing to play outside their regular CRYSA schedule of play must;

- i. Obtain CRYSA Executive approval to do so.
- ii. Provide the CRYSA with a detailed plan of where, when and how the travel will occur

Any team wishing to travel outside the Province or Country must;

- i. Obtain CRYSA BOD approval to do so.
- ii. Provide the BOD with a detailed plan of where, when and how the travel will occur

Travel Assistance

Each Tier 4 (House) Team wishing to participate in the Mini World Cup Tournament can apply to CRYSA to be reimbursed the registration fee by submitting the supporting receipt.

Each U12 to U18 Team (playing within the UISA Tier 3 League) wishing to participate in soccer tournaments, can apply to CRYSA for up to \$700.00 per year. Monies can only be used for BC Soccer tournament fees or tournament registration fees and must be supported by receipts.

Each U12 to U18 Team (playing within the UISA Tier 3 League) can apply to CRYSA for up to \$600.00 per year to assist with travel costs associated with Cup play (Island,



Coastal or Provincial) if travelling off Vancouver Island or to Powell River. Costs must be supported by receipts.

Each U12 to U18 Team (playing within the UISA Tier 3 League) can apply to CRYSA for additional funding to assist with travelling expenses associated with Provincial finals if travelling off Vancouver Island.

Tier 2 (VIPL) players registered with CRYSA can apply to CRYSA for funding to assist with travelling expenses associated with Cup play or Provincials (\$37.50/CRYSA player).

All the above funding is subject to the approval of the CRYSA Executive, unless the Executive feels it needs to be brought to the CRYSA Board of Directors.
